





There is an island that lies off the state of South Australia. It has 540 kilometres of coastline and is 150 kilometres long! It is Australia's third largest island, after Tasmania and Melville Island. Here, wildlife, adventure and exploring, beaches, local wines and sunsets are all on your doorstep.

It is almost impossible to describe the beauty of Kangaroo Island. There are high cliffs, thick forests, great sand dunes, wetlands and white beaches. It is wild but at the same time welcoming. Island Beach, also known as Millionaire's Row, is the most charming beach on Ki, as the locals call the island.

The island was mapped by the French explorer Nicolas Baudin after the British explorer Matthew Flinders landed there in 1800. It was Australia's first free settlement and was home to sealers, escaped convicts and runaway sailors.




