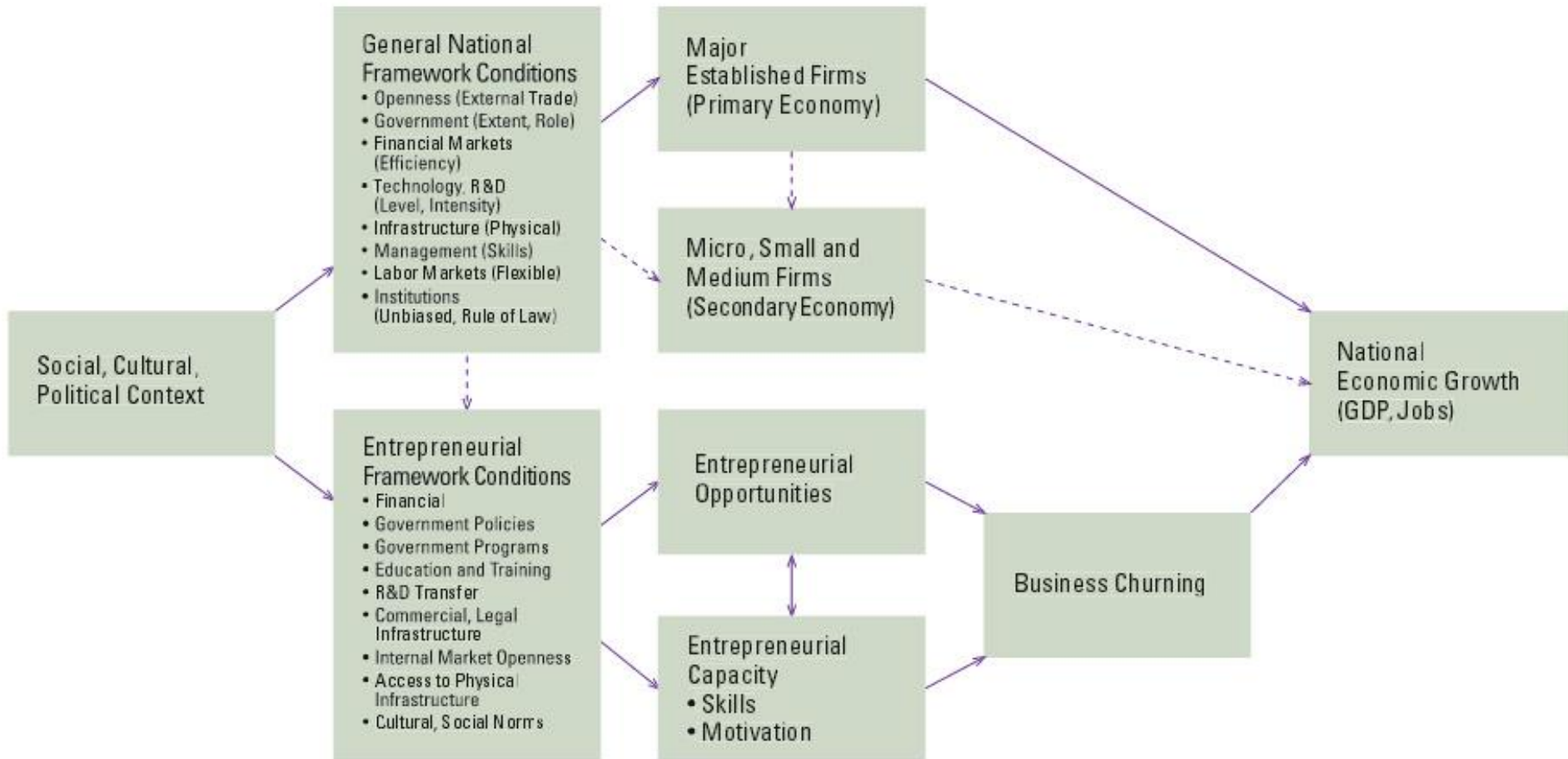

major objectives:

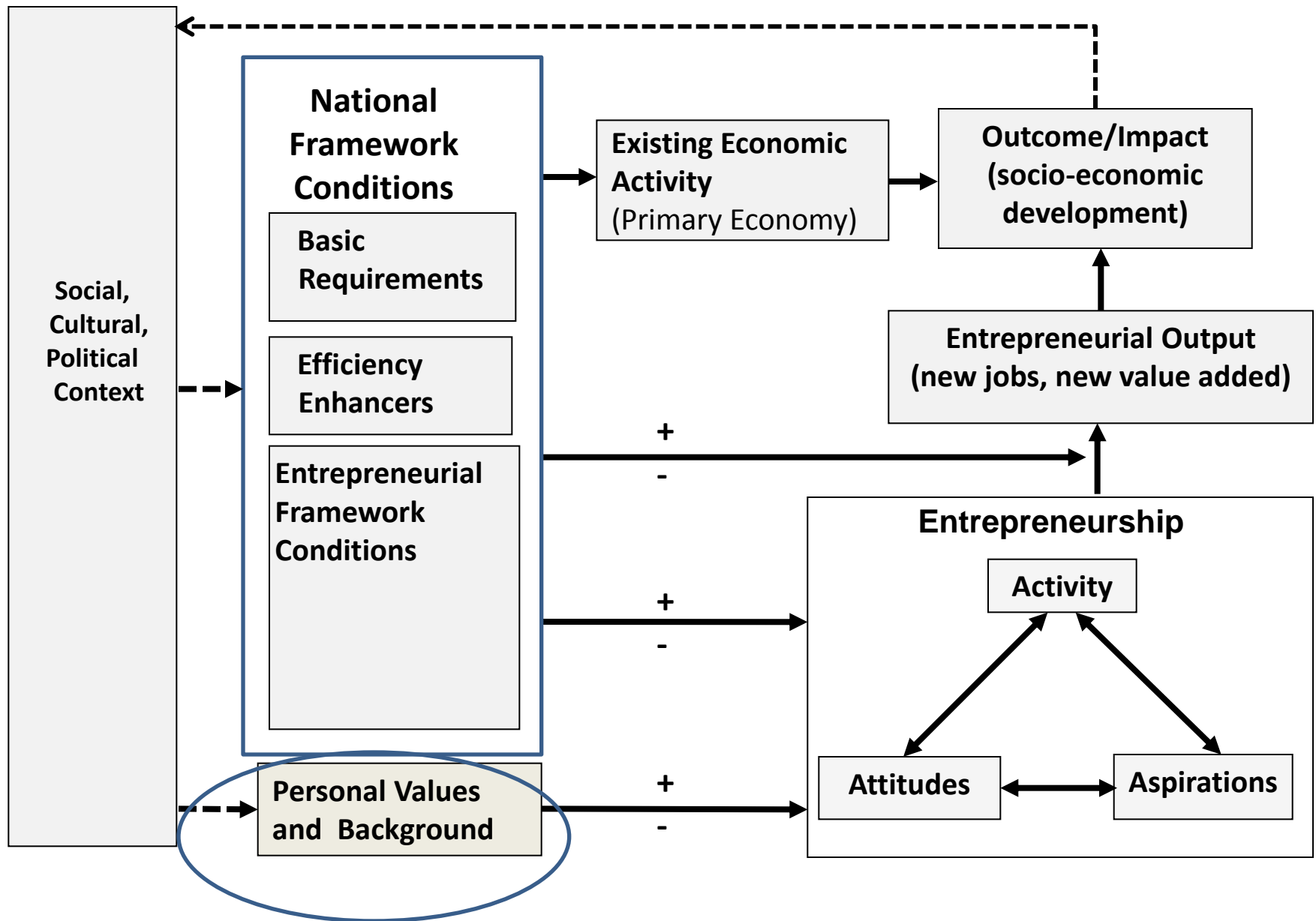
From its inception, the major objectives of the GEM research program have been to:

- suggest policies that may enhance the national level of entrepreneurial activity.

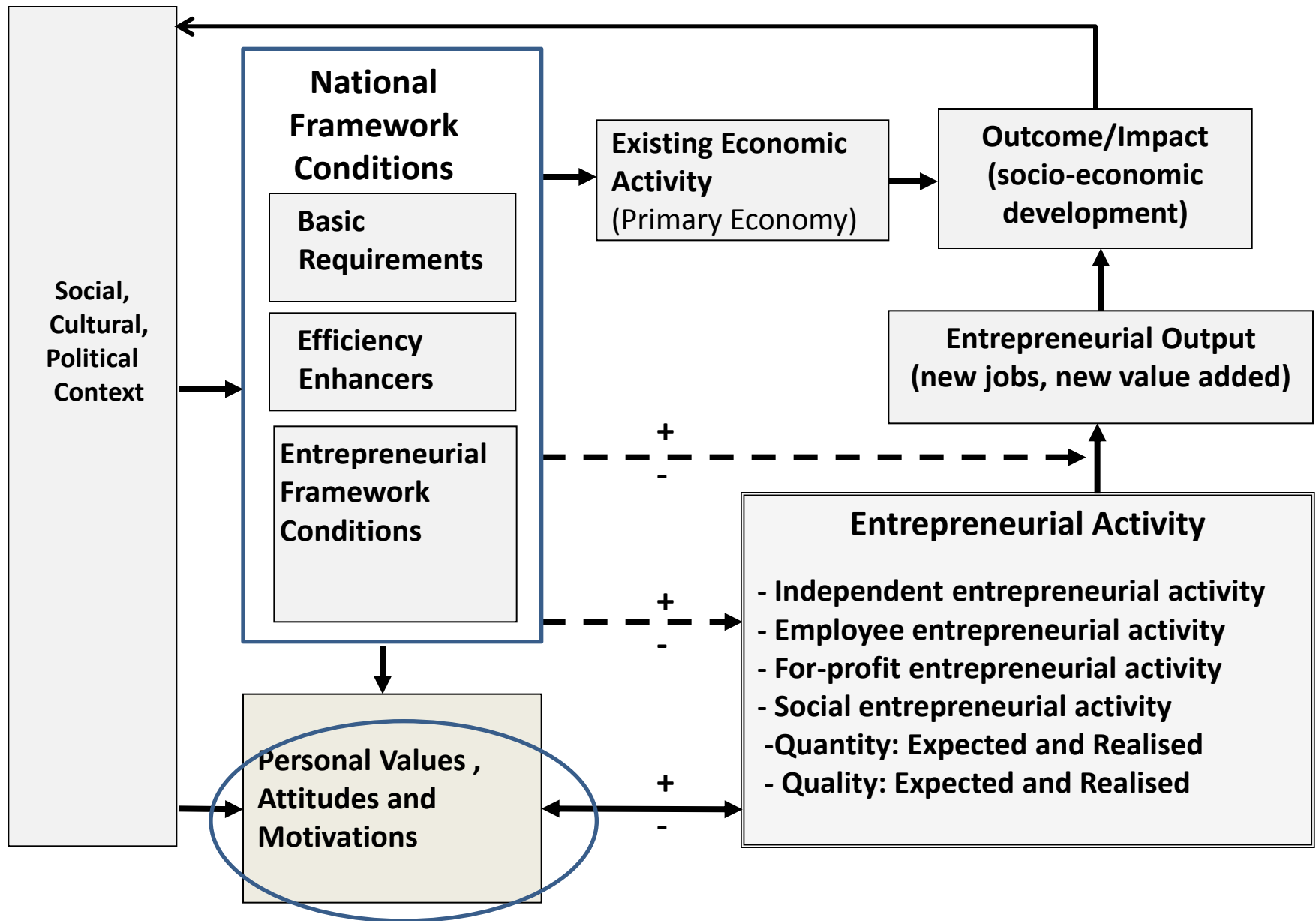
GEM – conceptual framework, 2002.



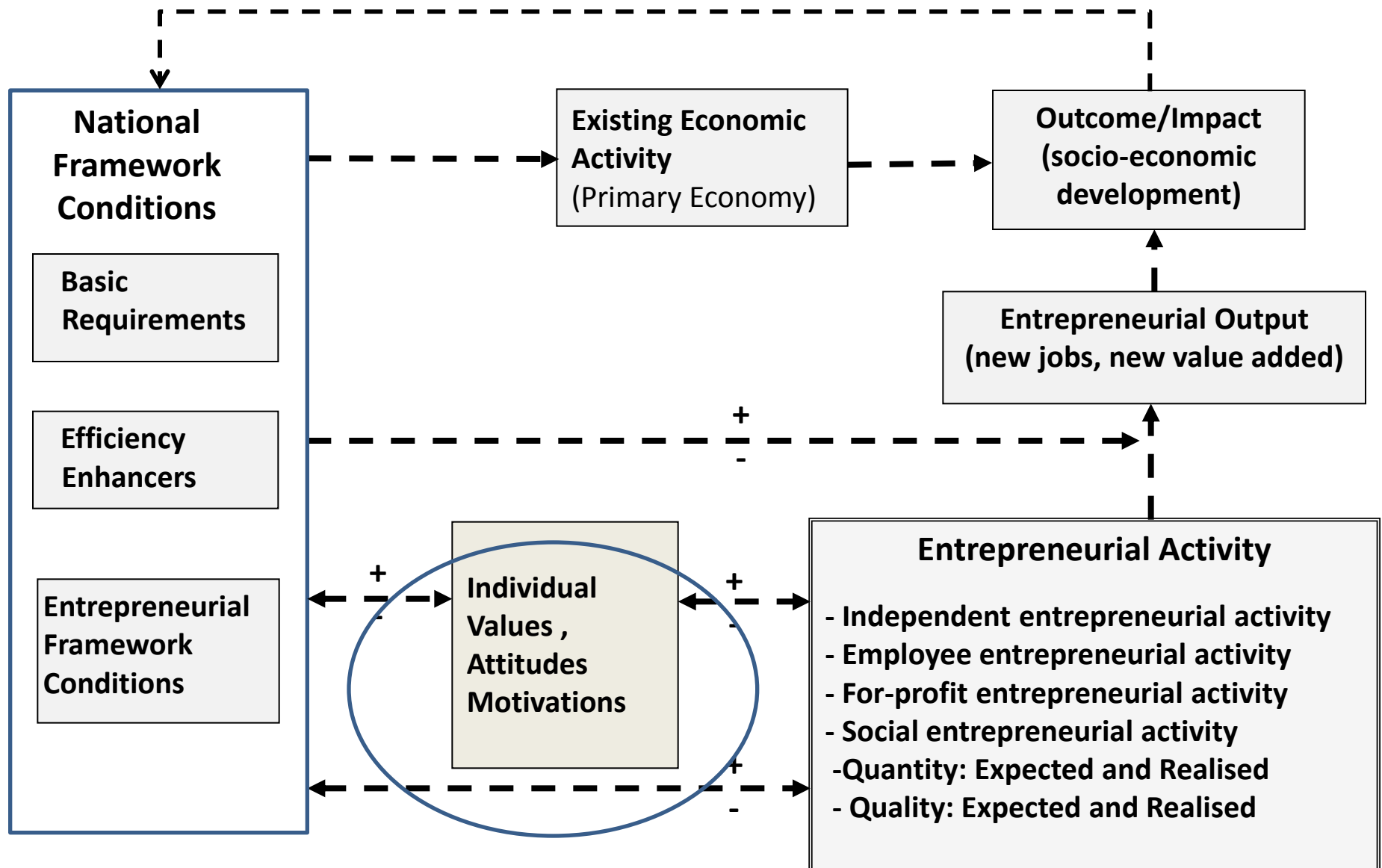
The GEM framework, 2012



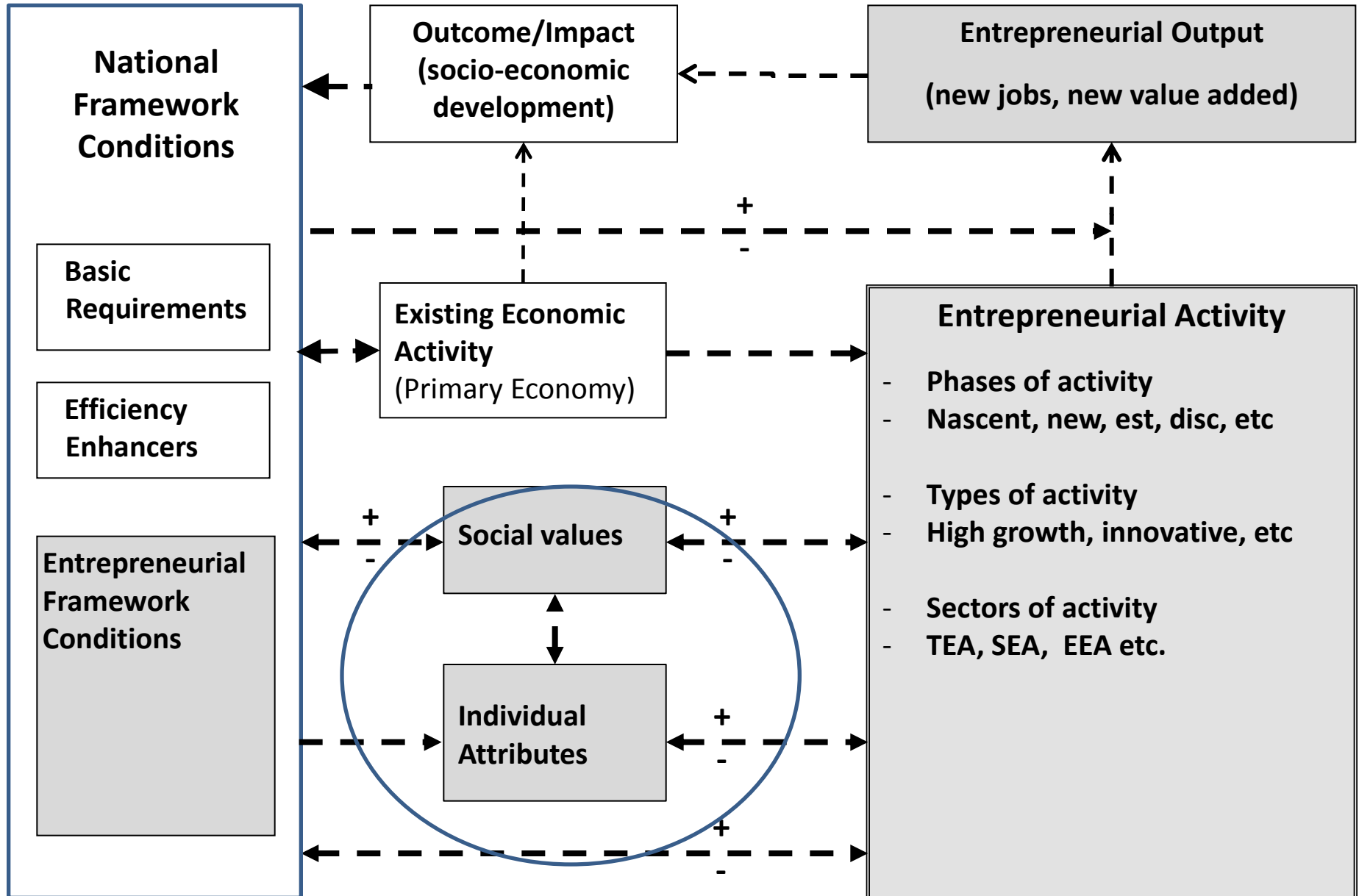
The GEM framework – discussion, 2013 - 1



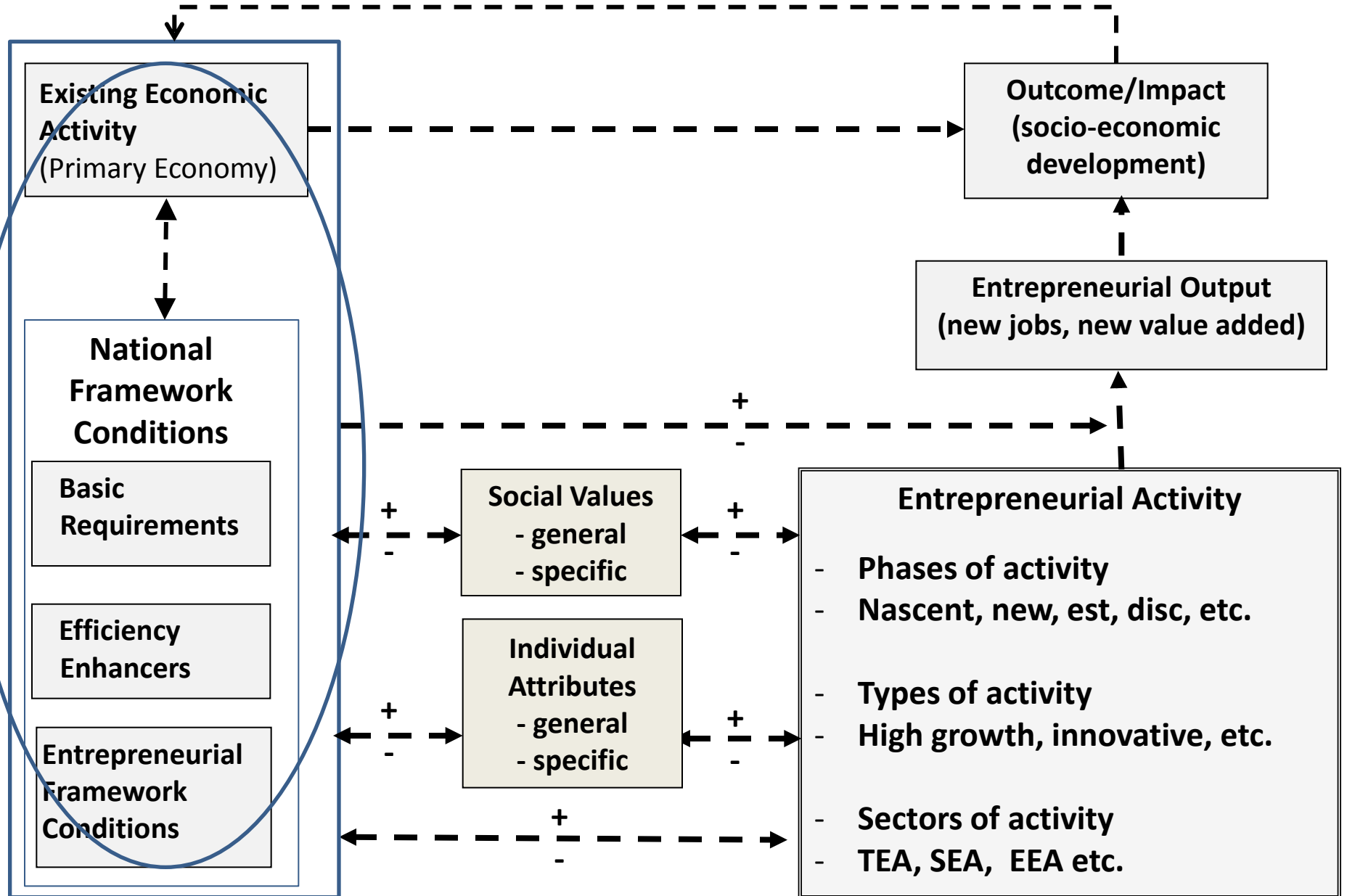

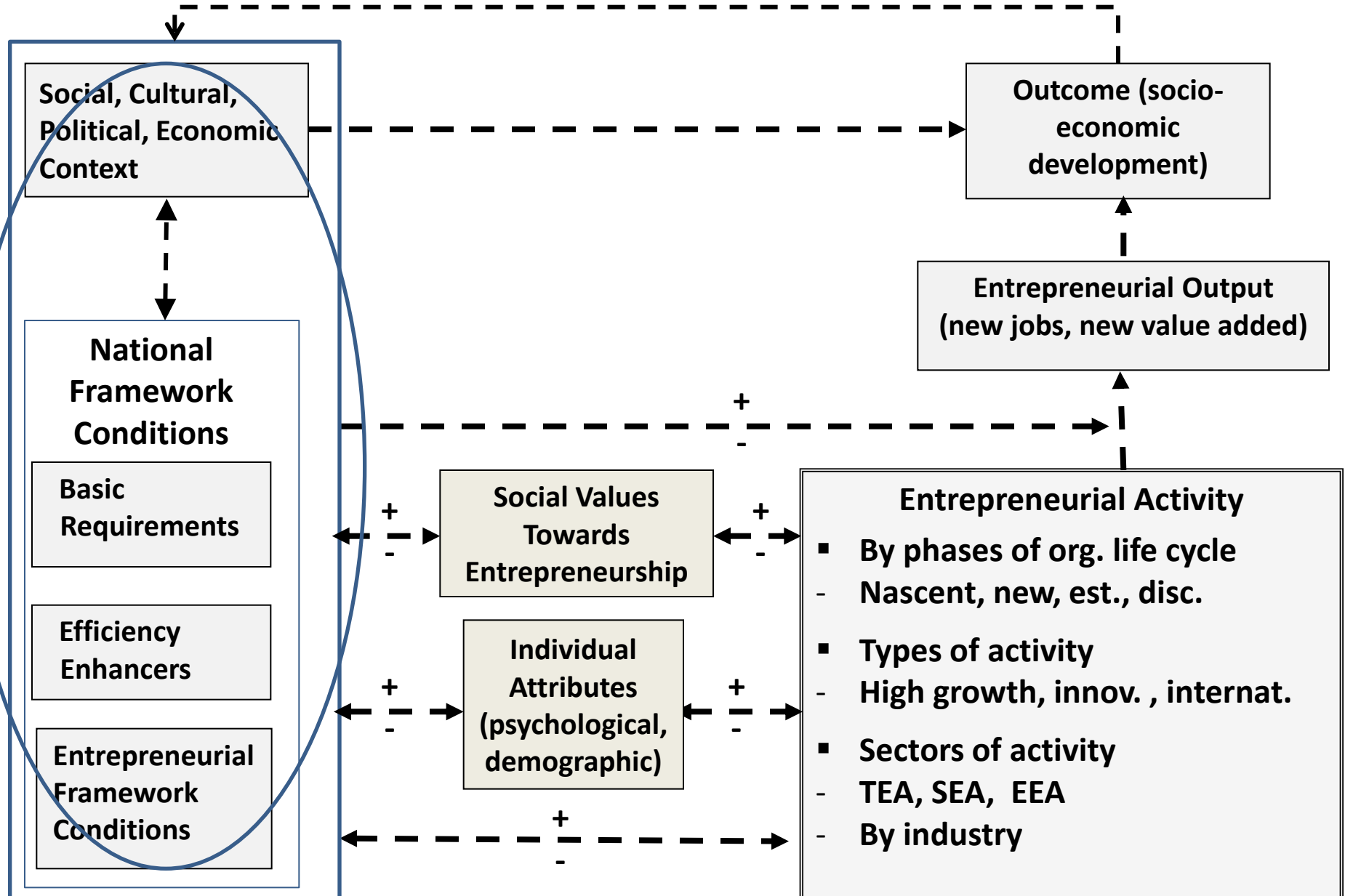


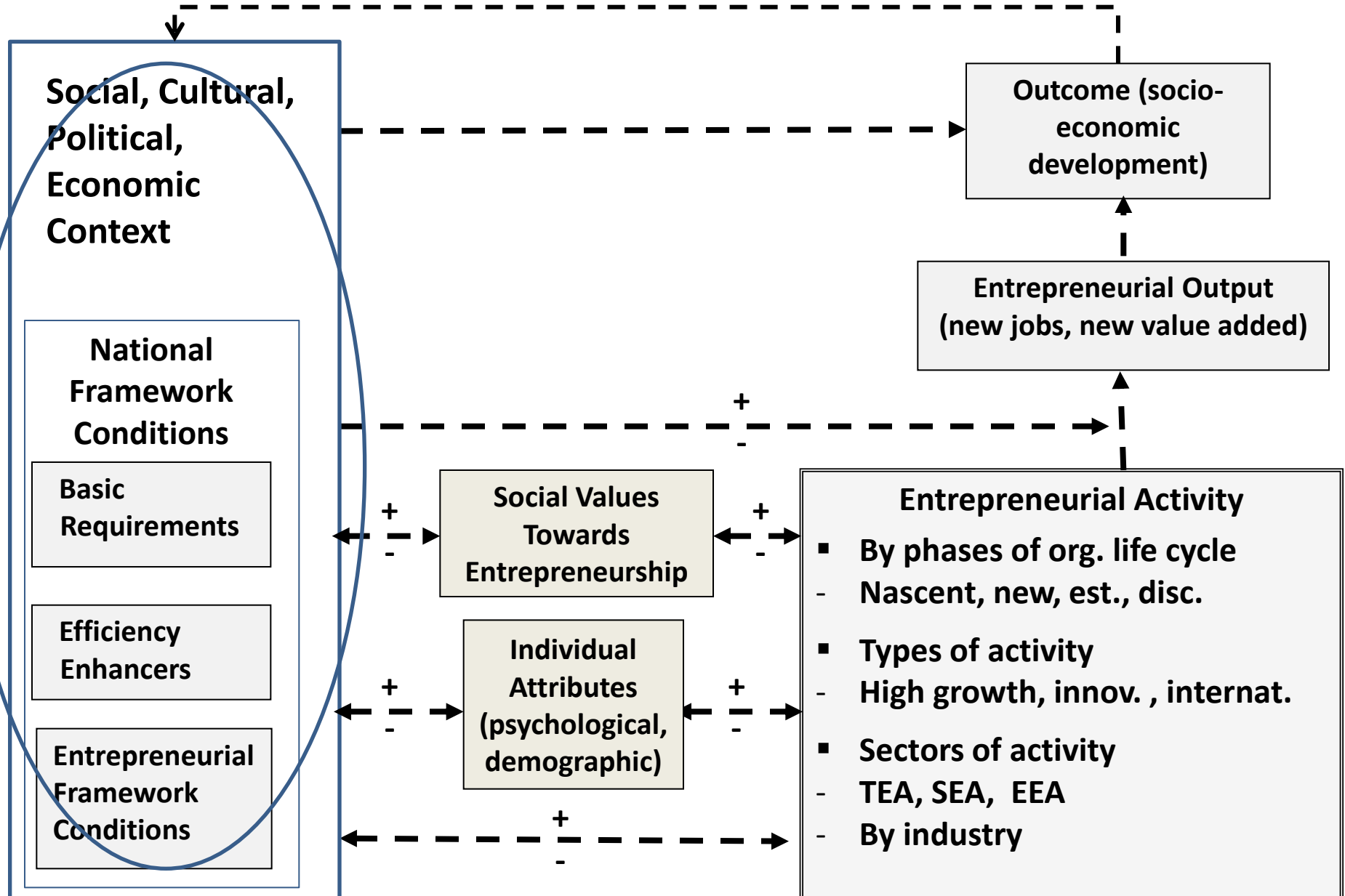
