

GEM datasets

There are two groups of datasets:

1. APS (**A**dult **P**opulation **S**urvey) datasets
2. NES (**N**ational **E**xpert **S**urvey) datasets

Each group consists of one dataset on national level and one dataset on master level.

National level refers to each country member of GEM consortium. Master level dataset contains data for all countries in the GEM for the particular year. This means that each country participating GEM in one year has available the following datasets:

1. National APS dataset: APS dataset for the particular country
2. Master APS dataset: APS dataset consisting of the selected data for all GEM countries
3. National NES dataset: NES dataset for the particular country
4. Master NES dataset: NES dataset consisting of the selected data for all GEM countries

APS (Adult Population Survey)

APS refers to dataset collected by interviewing (mostly by CATI method) representative sample of adult population in each country every year. In Croatia 2000 respondents 18-64 years of age are interviewed every year.

The questionnaire has been almost the same since 1999 when the GEM was initiated.

Blocks of questions in the questionnaire are the following:

- Entrepreneurs
- Business owners
- Potential entrepreneurs and discontinuers
- Attitudes about entrepreneurship
- Informal investors
- Innovation/Entrepreneurial employee activity

Based on the data collected all sorts of entrepreneurial indicators and analysis are calculated.

Every year GEM consortium prepares two essential datasets based on the APS collected data:

1. National APS dataset: APS dataset for the particular country
2. Master APS dataset: APS dataset consisting of the selected data for all GEM countries

NES (National Expert Survey)

NES refers to dataset collected by on-line interviewing around 40 entrepreneurs and experts in the field of entrepreneurship.

The questionnaire 2016 (3_2016 GEM NES Questionnaire National.docx) that is used in 2016 can be found [here](#).

The questionnaire has been almost the same since 1999 when the GEM was initiated.

Blocks of questions in the questionnaire are the following:

- Finance
- Government policies
- Government programs
- Education and training
- R&D transfer
- Commercial and services infrastructure etc.

Every year GEM consortium prepares two essential datasets based on the NES collected data:

1. National NES dataset: NES dataset for the particular country
2. Master NES dataset: NES dataset consisting of the selected data for all GEM countries
