- **A.** An **Introduction** in which you say:
 - what the issue is
 - what your purpose is
 What I want to do (today I this morning) is to ...
 My purpose/aim (today I this morning) is to ...
 - what your topic is
 I'm going to talk about ... / The topic of my presentation is ...
 - what points you will cover
 My presentation will be in 3
 parts.
 First I'll talk about / deal with ...
 Then / Next / Secondly, I'll
 consider / deal with ...
 Thirdly / Finally, I'll
 - when the listener can ask questions
 If you have any questions, please feel free to interrupt me.
 Finally, I'd be glad to answer any questions you may/might have.

B. A clear signal at the start of each part of the Body of the presentation:

Let me begin with ...

Right Now if we turn to ...

O.K. Let's deal next with ... + topic

So This brings me to ...
I would like to go on to ...

C. A clear summary/conclusion at the end of each part of the Body of the presentation, in which you restate your main point:

To summarise, ...

To conclude / In conclusion ...

- **D.** A Conclusion in which you:
- * repeat your main points
- 🜟 give your main conclusion

E. An Ending:

Well, that's all I have to say.
